The Gypsy Ramblers are a fivepiece band from Shepherdstown who play a blend of gypsy, jazz, 'dawg', and blues music. The band mixes original instrumental and vocal songs with unique covers. The group features Matt Robinson on mandolin, Butch Sanders on drums, Lavinia Reid on violin, Jeff Kauffman on guitar, and Bill Unger on bass.

Mark Cullinane is a singer and songwriter from Loudoun County, VA. His music is inspired by his rural country roots, childhood rearing, military background and love for the
